The green eggs and crab are served with jumbo lump crab meat, roasted tomato fondue, sweet corn and basil hollandaise and the steak and eggs any style is served up with chimichurri. For the sweet tooth, the lemon ricotta pancakes are fluffy as clouds with a blueberry Thai basil compote .
